1. the public footpath as shown by a bold black line on the order map with reference BXCR-ACM-BT-HW-SK-CE-00002 Rev P02 running between Brent Terrace and an existing public footpath running approximately westwards from Clitterhouse Crescent; and

2. the public footpath as shown by a bold black line on the attached map with reference BXCR-ACM-BT-HW-SK-CE-00003 Rev P01 running broadly parallel to Brent Terrace between a playground at the centre of development Plot 54 and a public footpath towards the south of the development plot

This order comes into force on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2021 but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
